- Posters must be flat 2-dimensional works on paper.
- Posters can be no larger than A3 (29.7 x 42 cm) in size.
- Entry is open to students from Prep to Year 10 only.
- 1 entry per student.
- Students must attend school or live within the City of Moonee Valley
- Posters must have a completed entry form secured to the back.
- Posters sent digitally to incinerator@mvcc.vic.gov.au must also include an attached completed entry form.
- Posters must be collected from the Gallery between 11am—4pm from Sat 29 November to Fri 12 December 2025 (Weds-Sat only). Contact the Gallery to make any alternate arrangements outside of these times.
- Any works not collected by 6 December will be disposed of at the discretion of the Gallery.
- Incinerator Gallery will do their best to ensure as many posters as possible are displayed but cannot guarantee all entries will be displayed.
- Posters may be digitised and displayed on screens across Council venues, published on MVCC websites and social media channels in order to promote the Bright Sparks exhibition and Incinerator Gallery.

Draw, paint, or collage a place that is special to you, a place that makes your heart sing. It might be a place that makes you feel safe and calm, like a cosy cubby in your room filled with fluffy cushions and fairy lights, or it may be a place full of colour and music that makes you want to dance and sing. A special place might be spending time at a familiar holiday spot with family and friends or visiting your grandparents’ house and sharing a delicious meal of your favourite food.

Maybe your special place is outside by the sea, swimming or gazing into rock pools, or in a lush green forest, or high up in a tree. It might even be an imaginary place filled with all your favourite things, including your favourite animals.

Let your imagination take you to your special place. We’re looking forward to seeing what you create. Gather your drawing equipment, coloured pens, paper, paint and glue, and start making your colourful, creative special place that tells us all about you.

Posters may be created from any medium; for example, paint, felt tipped pens, ink, photograph, digital print to name a few. Collaged artworks must be able to withstand handling and storage without elements falling off. Pastel or charcoal works must have been sprayed with fixative so not to smudge.

Posters will be displayed at a Pop-up exhibition at Crown Street Stables, Flemington from Saturday, 15 November 2025 to Sunday, 23 November 2025, 9am-3pm.

Teachers may enter their class’s posters as a batch of entries.

Families may enter their children's posters individually.

The Bright Sparks exhibition will open alongside Fireworks on Friday, 14 November at 5pm.

Prizes to be awarded at the opening are:

- Mayoral Award for Bright Sparks \$50 art supplies voucher
- Incinerator Bright Sparks Award \$50 art supplies voucher

Years 11 and 12 students are encouraged to enter their art and design works into **Fireworks**.
